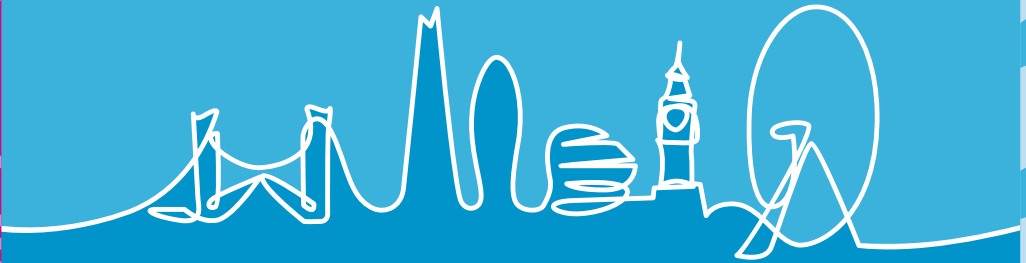

It's not right how low-paid and insecure work, high housing costs and our social security system are locking people into poverty.

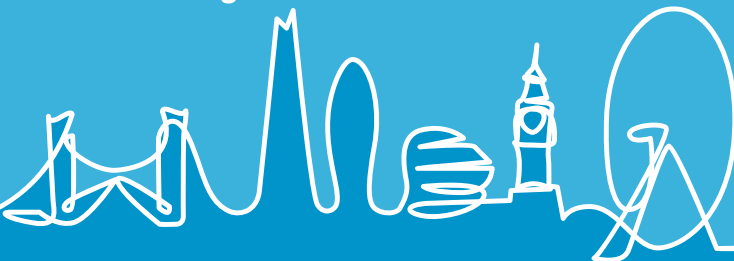
Nobody wants to live in a society where parents have to turn to foodbanks to feed their children, but for lots of families in our city, this is a reality every day.
